Kinetic Kids are children from all walks of life who experience the daily struggles of life-long challenges including: cerebral palsy, spina bifida, down's syndrome, autism, asperger's syndrome, brain tumors, cancers, or other neurological disorders.

Kinetic Kids provides health, recreational, and educational services to these children and their families. Their mission is to provide unique experiences through physical and creative activities in a supportive environment to children with special needs who may otherwise be excluded.

The Child and Adolescent Trauma Screener App -Texas Tech University HSC



Between 20-33% of children who experience abuse and neglect develop Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD). Over half the US population has suffered a trauma (i.e., an Adverse Childhood Experience - ACE) and the link between mental and physical health outcomes and ACE exposure has been firmly established.

Wide dissemination of a child trauma screener is critical in order to ensure children receive evidence based, effective interventions.

The Child and Adolescent Trauma Screener App (CATS App) was created by the Center for Superheroes at TTUHSC as an online trauma screener. The CATS App assists clinicians by automating the scoring of the measure and giving feedback to caregivers through visual representations of stop lights. The project's current goal is to make this CATS App readily available for pediatricians and mental health professionals to use.
